


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Myron W. Lewis, Fred Johanson, and David R. Pennell, all citizens of the United States, residing at Alliance, Stark county, Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clock Sign, of which the following is a specification.
