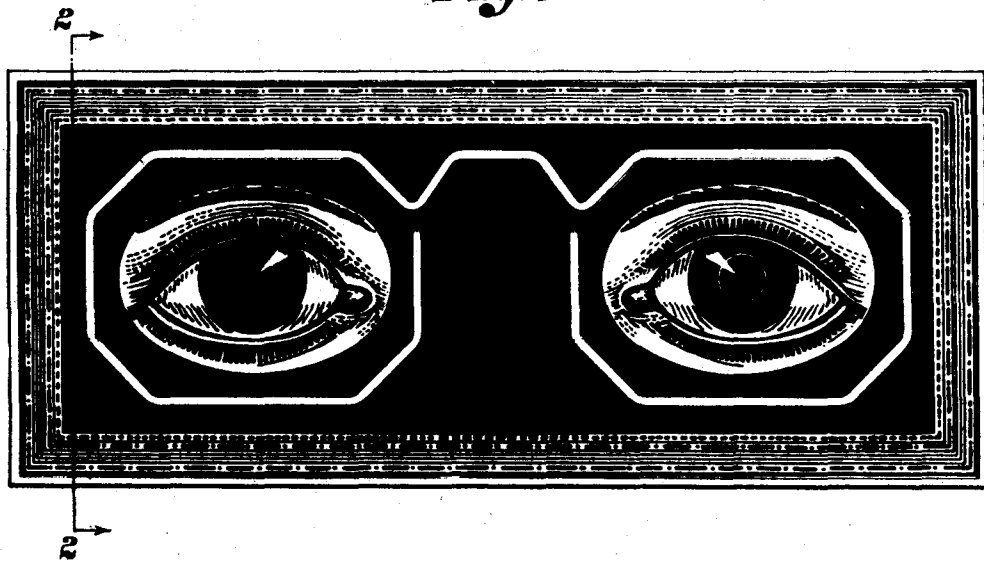
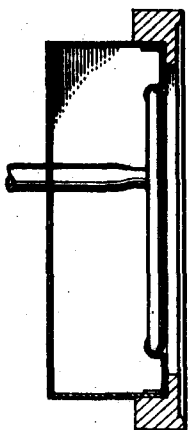

DESIGN FOR A NEON OPTICAL SIGN

Application filed March 5, 1931. Serial No. 38,949. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KAMIN, a subject of the King of Great Britain, and a resident of Lima, county of Allen, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Neon Optical Sign, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a sign showing my new design and Fig. 2 is a cross-section on the line 2—2 in Fig. 1.

The ornamental design for a neon optical sign, substantially as shown.
